By carrying cargo and a small number of guests (less than 200) on a regular voyage, Aranoa continues Aranui's legacy of inclusive tourism which has contributed to the company's success

in the Marquesas for the past 40 years. Through Aranoa, Aranui will slowly and sustainably work with the communities of the Austral archipelago to help them develop new tourism and economic opportunities, promote inter-island exchanges, and all while highlighting the vibrant landscapes and rich culture that make these islands so special.

Stabilisers and a dynamic positioning system ensure smooth and secure navigation, even in rough seas.
